



GUIDELINES FOR ACCEPTING NEW AND RETURNING STUDENTS

It is the goal of Riverside Christian School to provide an atmosphere that will lead children to Christ. It is, therefore, our policy to accept only those students who are desirous of a Christian education and willing to be in full harmony with the standards of the school.

- Students will be required to present transcripts or grades for the last quarter in school.
- Students will be required to present current standardized test scores.
- Students will be required to submit completed student questionnaire.
- Students will submit at least two references.
- Students will be required to appear for an entrance interview.
- Students need to achieve grades at average to above average levels to be accepted.
- Students who have had recurrent behavior problems in other schools will not be accepted.
- Students who have been expelled from other schools will not be accepted.
- Citizenship, as cited in the Student Handbook, will be used to evaluate returning students for admission.
- Because of limited school resources, students with special academic or behavioral need will not be accepted.
